➤ **Middle and Upper School**— Parents please drop off students at FCS as normal.

Dismissal –

Middle/Upper— students whose parent is not on site must check out with Mr. Smith before leaving the Celebration.

From FCS Turn **LEFT** onto Buck Mountain Road;

At lights, turn **LEFT** onto 220 N to I 581N;

Take I 581 to 81N.

Take Exit 146;

turn **RIGHT** onto Plantation Road. Travel 1/4 mile;

turn **RIGHT** onto Waldron DR. Travel .2 mile;

turn **RIGHT** onto Enon Dr.

Continue on Enon to Saint Francis Service Dogs.

Follow parking attendant's instructions.
