

## SEVENTH GRADE SUMMER READING 2025

Read the following two books before the first day of school.

1. Each student will read *The Golden Goblet by* Eloise Jarvis McGraw (ISBN 978-0140303353) as an introduction to literature centered on ancient civilizations.

Please compose an extended paragraph to be handed in on the first day of class with the following information:

- Title
- Author
- A brief summary of the book's plot (5-7 sentences).
- A description of the two main characters, Ranofer and Gebu (2-3 sentences per character).
- Two to three sentences telling whether or not the student would recommend the book to other readers, and why or why not.

This assignment may be typed or <u>neatly</u> handwritten in cursive using **black or blue ink only**.

The following criteria will be used to grade this assignment:

- a. The student's name appears in the top left corner of the paper. (2 points)
- b. The paper accurately summarizes the plot in five to seven sentences. (10 points)
- c. The paper contains a detailed description of each of the two main characters. (8 points)
- d. The paper contains two to three sentences telling whether or not the student would recommend the book and why or why not. (6 points)
- e. Correct spelling, grammar, and capitalization are used. (3 points)
- f. The paper is typed or <u>neatly</u> handwritten in cursive using black or blue ink and includes the pledge of integrity. (5 points)

- 2. Each student will also read <u>one additional book</u> chosen from the **Grade 7 Reading List**.
  - In a detailed paragraph, write a summary of the additional book you read.
  - The summary should be typed or **neatly handwritten in cursive using only black or blue ink**.
  - The following criteria will be used to grade this assignment: a. The student's name appears in the top left corner of the paper. (2 points)
    - b. The paper contains 6-8 sentences summarizing the book. (10 points)
    - c. The paper is typed or neatly **handwritten in cursive using black or blue ink**, and includes the pledge of integrity. (4 points)

Students should affirm the integrity of their work by writing the following pledge **in black or blue ink** on each assignment and <u>signing it</u>:

I have read this whole book, and all the written work is my own.
