Only clothes purchased through Lands' End will be considered appropriate dress code. Specific styles can be found at www.landsend.com, Preferred School Number: 900042946.

- a. Boys
 - i. Khaki or Blue Pants/shorts with belts (no belts required for JK/K)
 - ii. Belts must be either brown or black leather or leather-like material.The buckle should not be distracting.
 - iii. Three polo choices: Navy, Red, Purple
 - iv. Footwear
 - 1. Should not be torn or show excessive wear.
 - 2. Shoes:
 - Students may wear tennis shoes or simple leather or leather-like shoes.
 - Shoes should not "light up," have rollers, and be non-scuffing.
 - Shoes must have closed toes and backs.
 - No crocs, sandals, boots*, or five-finger shoes.
 *Boots are permitted 6th-12th.
 - 1. Socks must be solid white, navy, or black and no longer than mid-calf.' Small logos are permitted.
 - v. A Lands's End long-sleeve Oxford shirt (white) is an option for 9-12th.
 Students have the option of wearing a tie or bow tie.
- b. Girls
 - i. Khaki or Blue pants/shorts with belts (no belts required for JK/K).
 - ii. Belts must be either brown or black leather or leather-like material.The buckle should not be distracting.
 - iii. Khaki or Blue skirts/skorts/(Jumpers JK-5th only) should be within 4 inches from center of knee.
 - NOTE: Final decisions on length will be made by the Division Administrator or his/her designee. Any decisions regarding acceptability are not to be misconstrued as a comment on any

girl's modesty or attitudes. In reality, this is an arbitrary standard but is the one Faith has chosen.

- iv. Three polo choices: Navy, Red, Purple
- v. Modesty (bike) shorts required for JK-5th grade girls (Solid color navy or black only, please)
- vi. Any hose (leggings/stockings) white, navy, or black and covering ankles
- vii. Footwear
 - 1. Should not be torn or show excessive wear.
 - 2. Shoes:
 - Students may wear tennis shoes or simple leather or leather-like shoes.
 - Shoes should not "light up," have rollers, and be non-scuffing.
 - Shoes must have closed toes and backs.
 - No crocs, sandals, boots*, or five-toed shoes.
 *Boots are permitted 6th-12th.
 - If heels, 2" or less
 - Socks must be solid white, navy, or black and no longer than mid-calf.' Small logos are permitted.

vii. A Lands' End long sleeve Oxford shirt (white) is an option for 9-12th.

- c. Any student may opt to wear a navy crewneck sweatshirt or a red or navy fleece jacket, with sleeves, to class. These items must be purchased though Lands' End, and the item must be embroidered with the school logo. An approved dress code shirt must be worn underneath the crewneck or fleece jacket.
- d. Warrior Wear
 - Warrior Wear is defined as any shirt provided by or purchased through Faith Christian School either during the Warrior Wear Sales, for special events (ie Project Faith or the Become a Warrior Campaign), or club t-shirts.
 - ii. May be worn on designated dress down days.

- iii. May be worn on designated game days only.
- iv. May be worn on Fridays.

Additional:

- 1. Hats and decorative scarves (includes headbands with long scarves)should not be worn.
- 2. Girls may wear hair-bows, clips, and headbands.
- 3. Undergarments should not be visible.
- 4. Boys' undershirts should be white including neck band and should not extend beyond the outer garment's hem or sleeve.
- 5. No holes, tears, fringe, frays or visible patches.

Grooming:

- 1. Hair style and length should not distract a student at school.
- 2. Hair must be of a natural color and neatly groomed kept out of the eyes.
- 3. Students should not wear "faddish" haircuts such as Mohawks, beads in the hair, or distracting hair accessories.
- 4. Visible tattoos and body piercings are not permitted at any time while on campus and while representing the school in any function or event.
- 5. Young women may wear up to two earrings per ear.
